Arriving to the town Mr. Rudy wanted to go, he took one of the cases and got off from the bus.

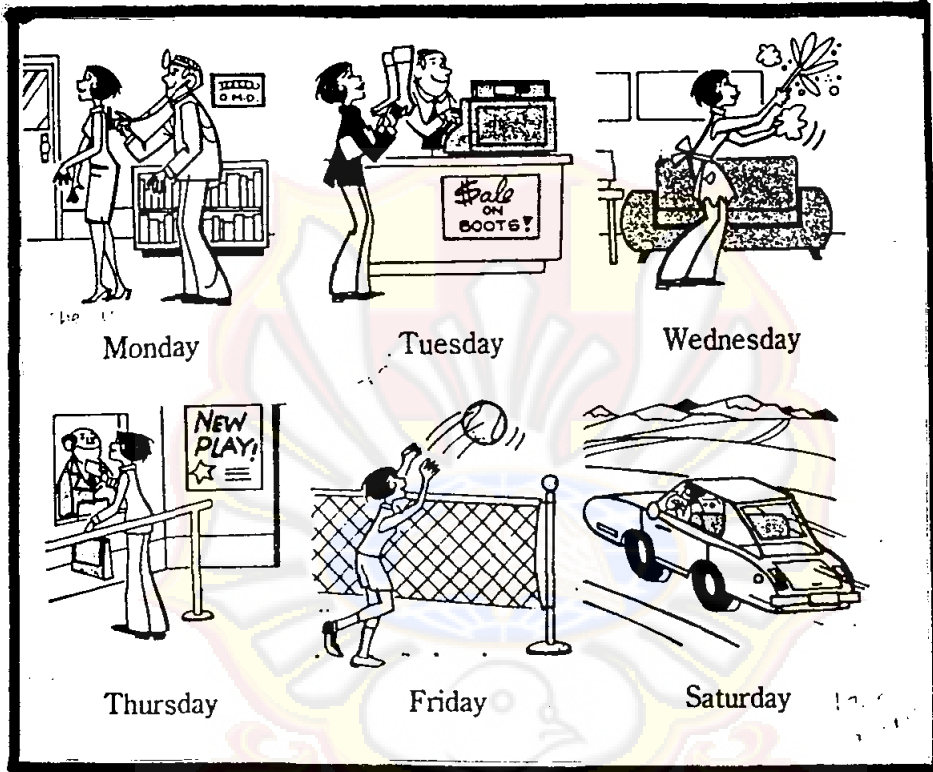
He went by bus and sat beside a man.

Mr. Rudy directly went to the place where was written on the book and he met the owner of the case he had took.

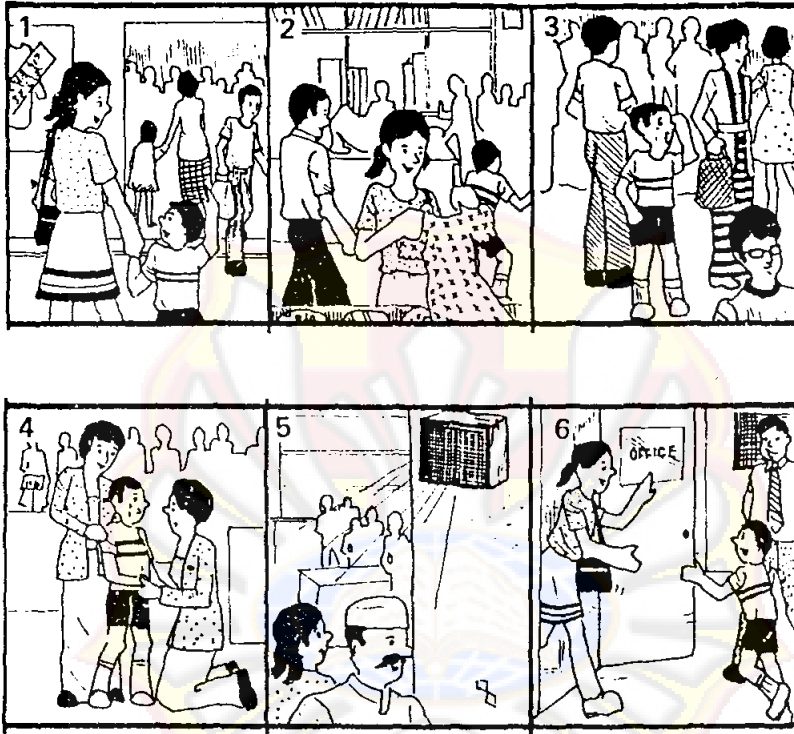
